Field Guide to the Plants of Northern Botswana including the Okavango

This field guide includes over 500 flowering herbs, trees, shrubs, ferns, grasses, sedges and sedge-like plants, illustrated with over 2,000 colour photographs. Plants are arranged by flower colour. Two detailed sections on grasses and sedges are ordered by inflorescence structure, then by family, genus and species. Key identifying features are listed, along with habitat, flowering period and uses and beliefs.

Field Guide to Wild Flowers of South Africa

John Manning

This field guide describes more than 1,100 wild flowers, highlighting the most conspicuous species and those most likely to be encountered across the country. An identification aid and keys guide users to the correct family and genus, while individual species descriptions, photographs, distribution maps and flowering seasons help pinpoint the plant.

Guide to Succulents of Southern Africa

Twenty-five per cent of southern African flora is succulent in nature. The book covers approximately 250 individual species. Each entry features a photograph and distribution map.
