Guide to the Flowers of Western China

Christopher Grey-Wilson and Phillip Cribb

This pictorial flora for western China describes and illustrates over 2,400 plants, and while providing a field guide to many of the commoner and colourful elements of the flora, it also includes many endemics and plants of great rarity. Reportedly contains the largest collection of photographs of Chinese plants ever published. The plant families are arranged following the latest DNA-based classification.

Field Guide to the Plants of East Sabah

Rogier de Kok and Tim Utteridge

This book deals with the seed plants of the lowlands of East Sabah, Malaysia, and features the 84 most commonly encountered families in the lowland rainforest of Danum Valley, Maliau Basin and Imbak Canyon. Plant families are presented alphabetically, and each carries a description, with field characters and descriptions of the key genera. Each family is illustrated with colour photographic images.

Common Indian Wild Flowers

Isaac Kehimkar

This is an illustrated field guide to the indigenous flora of the Indian plains and peninsula. The book contains 240 photographs of common Indian wild flowers with explanatory notes on the size, habit, habitat, distribution and other interesting features. The species have been arranged in taxonomic sequence, and common names in English and regional names have also been given. There are separate sections on the topography, climate and vegetation of India, on how to identify and photograph wild flowers, and on conservation issues related to them.

The Wild Flowers of Kanchenjunga Biosphere Reserve, Sikkim

D. Maity and G.G. Maiti

This book highlights 260 wild flowers spread throughout the area as well as in the Himalayas (Nepal, Bhutan, Tibet) which is a similar phytogeographic region. It covers 256 species of angiosperms and 4 species of gymnosperms. The book includes botanical names, local names, a description of important features, habitat and extent of distribution.
