Field Guide to Wild Flowers of Southern Europe

Paul Davies and Bob Gibbons

This identification guide describes many of the plants of Spain, Portugal, southern France, Italy, and Malta. Colour photographs, line-drawings and text describe 1,200 species.

Flowers of Europe: A Field Guide

Oleg Polunin

This guide describes 2,800 of the most common wild flowers to be found growing in Europe. For over 1,900 of these species, the book provides descriptions, their distribution across the continent, and their uses as poisons, dyes, foodstuffs, or medicines. It also includes keys to the families and genera. The book's 192 pages of colour plates contain approximately 1,000 photographs of flowering plants. Line drawings are used to illustrate a further 280 species. There are lists of plant names in French, German, and Italian.

Flowers of Greece and the Balkans: A Field Guide

Oleg Polunin

This volume names and describes nearly 3,000 species of flowering plants in the region. The book includes 80 pages of colour plates with almost 500 photographs of flowers.

Flowers of South-West Europe: A Field Guide

Oleg Polunin and B. E. Smythies

This book describes over 2,400 different flowering plants and includes hundreds of line drawings, colour photographs, and detailed keys.

A Naturalist's Guide to the Wild Flowers of Britain & Northern Europe

Andrew Cleave

This photographic identification guide to the commoner wild flowers of Britain and northern Europe features 280 species.

New Holland Concise Wild Flower Guide

Wildlife Trusts

This illustrated mini field guide contains information on the most common wild flowers of Britain and the near Continent. It covers more than 180 species, all of which are illustrated with colour artworks that show details of the flowers, leaves and growth habit of the plant. A written account covering size, description, habitat, flowering time, distribution and habits appears on the same page. Also included is a foldout insert with at-a-glance illustrations showing flowers grouped by colour.

Photographic Guide to Wildflowers of Britain and Europe

With thumbnail outlines of each family group, the text describes key identification features and colour photographs illustrate each species.

A Selection of Wildflowers of Southern Spain

Betty Molesworth Allen

This book describes more than 200 common plants of the region, each accompanied by a color illustration and simple text.

Wild Flowers of Britain and Europe

Wolfgang Lippert

Covers over 250 of the commonest flowers found in Britain and Europe. Each species is illustrated and described in detail in the text. The flowers are organized by colour.

Wild Flowers of Britain and Europe

Margot Spohn

Over 450 species of wildflowers are covered, each illustrated with paintings and photographs. The images show what the plant looks like in its habitat and also focus on specific features such as the leaves or flower head. Additional information includes when the plant is in flower, the approximate petal size and preferred habitat.

The Wild Flowers of Britain and Ireland: The Complete Guide to the British and Irish Flora

Marjorie Blamey, Richard Fitter and Alastair Fitter

This field guide contains over 2,000 detailed colour paintings and more than 800 maps for the British and Irish flora. It includes specific details about plants appearing in certain areas and coloured maps designed to make location and identification easy. The book also covers details of local specialities for the Isles of Scilly. Information about grasses, sedges, rushes, horsetails and clubmosses is included, as well as coverage of ferns.

Wild Flowers of Britain & Northern Europe

Richard Fitter, Alastair Fitter and Marjorie Blamey

A guide to wild trees, shrubs and flowering plants covering the whole of Britain and Ireland, plus Europe from the Arctic to the Alps. Nearly 2,000 species are described, and 1,450 are illustrated in colour.

Wildflowers of Britain and Northwest Europe (Dk Handbooks)

Christopher Grey-Wilson

A visual recognition guide to wild flowers in Britain, with annotated photographs to pick out key distinguishing features.

Wildflowers of Great Britain, Europe, Africa & Asia

Michael Lavelle

This book is a survey of the floral diversity of Europe, Asia and Africa. It presents more than 260 species of flowers, grasses, herbs, rushes, sedges, trees, shrubs, and aquatic and carnivorous plants.
