The main sections cover 250 common species, and each account includes colour photographs which aid identification. Plants are grouped according to the colour of their most conspicuous feature, usually flowers, with additional sections for trees and grasses. Within each colour group they are organized alphabetically by botanical family. A short description gives details of appearance, habitat, uses and worldwide distribution.

A Handbook of the Yemen Flora

This book includes descriptions of all the species known from the region with keys for their identification. More than 40 plants are illustrated in colour and others by line drawings. In addition there are sections on the history of botanical exploration, phytogeography and the ecology and distribution of vegetation types. Appendices include lists of Arabic plant names and poisonous plants.
